The rich mangroves were once used as a spawning location and nursery by prawn and fish farmers. Since January 2002, Sungei Buloh has been protected as a nature reserve in recognition of the rich biodiversity that it harbours. It is a member of the East Asia-Australasian Flyway Partnership (EAAFP) and Singapore's first ASEAN Heritage Park.
